### C. Agrometeorological Advisories

General conditions	<p>A low pressure area has formed over southeast Arabian Sea &amp; adjoining Lakshadweep area today, the 13th May morning (0830 hrs IST). It is very likely to become well marked over Lakshadweep area by 14th morning, concentrate into a Depression over the same region by 15th morning and intensify into a Cyclonic Storm during the subsequent 24 hours. It is very likely to intensify further and move north-northwestwards towards Gujarat and adjoining Pakistan coasts. It is likely to reach near Gujarat coast around 18th May evening</p>
Precautions	<p>Transport harvested produces like rice, rubber, copra, pulses, vegetables, seeds, etc. and fertilizers from open places to store houses.</p> <p>Beware of heavy wind and lightning. Avoid working when there is lightning. Don't rest under the trees and in weak shelters.</p> <p>Give strong propping to banana, vegetables and other soft stemmed crop plants.</p> <p>Neither keep the livestock in open places, nor allow them for grazing. They should be sheltered under strong roofs.</p> <p>Postpone activities like fertilizer application, sowing etc till climatic conditions become favourable.</p>
