General Advisory: - Proper mulching can be followed to conserve soil moisture. Since air temperature is increasing, it is a desirable practice to bury fresh or dried coconut husk around the palm to conserve soil moisture.

nsure water availability in paddy fields. The micronutrient ficiency of paddy can be managed by spraying 10 gram of ddy sampoorna in one litter of water. nce dry weather condition is prevailed, there is a chance of ites attack in banana. Apply Wettable sulphur three gram per
e litre of water.
o control the slow wilt disease in pepper, apply neem cake at e base of pepper plants. Also apply 25 grams of the bio control ent Pisilomyces lilacinus at the base of each plant. If the attack severe, drench the basin of each plant with three gram Copper xy Chloride (COC) per one litre of water.

Animal Husbandry: - During cloudy condition, avoid bathing the cow and washing the cattle shed, otherwise more heat will be build up. Provide proper air circulation using fans in cattle shed. Assure increased ventilation in the cattle shed. Ensure sufficient supply of clean drinking water to the animals. (CAADECCS, KVASU, Mannuthy).
