Weather summary / Alert: As per the forecast of IMD, there is a chance of moderate rainfall in isolated places of the district. Normal to above normal rainfall is expected in Kerala.

General and Agrometeorological Advisories for Thrissur District

Special crop management is required for agricultural crops during monsoon season. Proper drainage facilities have to be ensured. If the soil is more acidic, add lime as per soil testing. Pesticides should not be applied during rainy period. Provide supports to banana crops. Make the vegetable pandals stronger. To protect farmers and livestock from lightning and thunder avoid standing in open areas.

Rice (virippu) Panicle initiation	Bacterial Leaf blight	To control and prevent bacterial leaf blight in paddy, dissolve 20 g of cow dung in one litre of water and spray the supernatant liquid by mixing with 20g of pseudomonas.			
stage	Brown Plant	There is a chance of brown plant hopper attack in rice. Spray 2 gram			
	Hopper (BPH)	Thiamethoxam per ten litre of water.			
		As a prophylactic measure to control quick wilt of pepper, add 2 kg			
Pepper	Quick wilt	Trichoderma to a mixture of 90 kg FYM and10 kg neem cake and kept for two weeks with sufficient moisture. Add 2.5 kg of this mixture to the base of each matured pepper vine			
Nutmeg	Leaf fall	During rainy season, there is a chance of leaf fall in nutmeg. As a prophylactic measure to manage leaf fall in nutmeg, spray 1% Bordeaux mixture or drench the basin. Proper drainage facilities have to be ensured			
Cucurbitaceous Vegetables	Downy mildew	During rainy season, there is a chance of downy mildew attack in cucurbitaceous vegetables. Spray 2.5gm Mancozeb per one litre of water under the leaves. Pesticides should not be applied during rainy period.			
Animal Husbandry: Vaccinate animals against foot and mouth disease. Care should be taken to prevent rat					

breeding in the premises of cattle shed to prevent leptospirosis. (CAADECCS, KVASU, Mannuthy)
